Company Description (Please write a short description of your organization, its core activities, and its relationship to biodiversity and Ethical BioTrade)	<p>"Since its foundation in 2007, Olivea BF has chosen to develop a "sustainable supply chain" approach in order to improve and control its shea nut procurement chain (from organic or conventional crops). This approach is based on transparent, long-term relationships with women's cooperatives. The organisation's strategy is clearly defined by the intent to fix revenue to the tree through a local relationship with the women who are the producers and main people in charge of the natural shea resource. Social and solidarity economy must preserve this resource. The goal is therefore to let the harvesters and families who live in the region understand that each tree has a real, measurable economic value in order to avoid the destruction of this resource, to the benefit of the families, the organisation and the environment.</p> <p>In 2011, the organisation procures 44% of the purchased volumes from producers' organisations ("sustainable supply chains") and 56% from shea nut traders. Its aim is to work 100% with "sustainable supply chains" within the next two years.</p> <p>It is worth noting that the organisation has chosen to manufacture the butter in Burkina Faso, with the aim to keep the maximum amount of added value in the country through the local production of butter, despite the high cost of electricity. Besides, no water is used in the process that was chosen for manufacturing the butter, since water is a scarce resource in the area and quality control is often lacking</p>
